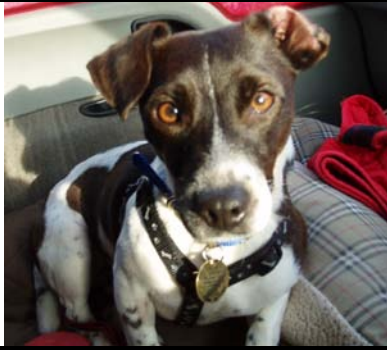
3. Alfie

17. Scooby



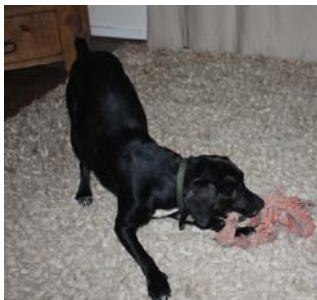
